Day 1: Transfer to Florence

Breakfast at the hotel and then transfer by bus to Florence. Check in at your hotel located in the city center. Rest of the afternoon you are free. Tonight there will be a fun and delicious Tuscan cooking class accompanied with local Tuscan wines. A great way to kickoff our adventure in Tuscany!



Day 2: Birthplace of the Renaissance | Florence City Tour

After breakfast enjoy a small group tour of the Florence including a guided visit to the Accademia Gallery. **The first part of the tour** starts in front of the main entrance of the Accademia Gallery where your guide will explain why the **Michelangelo's David is the most recognizable** symbol of Florence. How did the genius of **Michelangelo** meet the challenge of extracting the pathos of a being and fixing it forever in time in the **Pietà**. You will have the answers to all your questions. After the guided tour you will have some free time to wander around on your own to have lunch (not included). **The second part of the tour** includes a walking tour. You will enjoy an excellent and complete introductory dedicated to the facts and secrets of two thousand years of Florentine history, from the city's **Roman origins**, including the **Ponte Vecchio**, the famous **Uffizi courtyard**, and the wonders of the architecture of **Brunelleschi's Dome** which overlooks the Baptistery golden '**Gates of Paradise**'. Rest of the afternoon at your leisure.



Day 3: Siena & San Gimignano | Chianti Winery Visit

Close your eyes and find yourself in the magical light of Piazza del Campo in Siena. This is where the famous Palio horse races take place. **Siena** welcomes you among the **Tuscan landscapes** that embrace the area. Already thriving in the Etruscan times, Siena boasts very ancient origins. Now, reopen your eyes to enjoy the atmosphere of the rolling hills of the **Chianti region**. Here you will visit a family-run winery and enjoy a delicious Tuscan lunch paired with local wines. Finally, you will head to gorgeous **San Gimignano**! Renowned for its medieval towers and picturesque streets. Enjoy a guided tour of this **UNESCO World Heritage** town, and have free time to explore, shop for local specialties, or climb the campanile (bell tower) for panoramic views of the breathtaking Tuscan countryside. Return to Florence in the late afternoon. ***Departure tomorrow morning**

After breakfast depart to Bologna's airport to catch your flight back to the USA.
